

What are “Net Acres”?

Also referred to as “productive acres”, the net acres of a sale are the gross acres minus the non-productive acres, which may include road right-of-ways, large landings, brush patches, and rock outcrops.

What are the species codes in the inventory report?

GF = Grand Fir

WH = Western Hemlock

DF = Douglas-fir

WL = Western Larch

WRC = Western Red Cedar

PP = Ponderosa Pine

WP = White Pine

LP = Lodgepole Pine

ES = Engelmann Spruce

SF = Subalpine Fir
